Mr. Jeffrey S. MacKay will discuss recent changes to the State stormwater regulations and how these changes affect PennDOT's transportation design, construction and maintenance operations. He will highlight the changes that have the most impact on PennDOT, and discuss how PennDOT plans to deal with them in terms of design manuals, policies, and procedures. This presentation will include five key topics:

- Recent changes to 25 PA Code 102 and how they affect PennDOT
- How NPDES permits apply to PennDOT operation and what types of activities are exempt
- Update on the EPA Stormwater Rule on effluent limitations on construction discharges from sites
- PennDOT's MS4 permit status
- Current state of DEP's Act 167 program and its implications on future projects

Mr. MacKay is a principal at NTM Engineering and advises PennDOT's Central Office on policy related to drainage, stormwater, and erosion and sedimentation control. He instructs eight technical courses for PennDOT, a preparatory course for the PE Exam, and a Low Impact Development course for ASCE.
